(4TH - 8TH GRADERS)
REGISTRATION DEADLINE: June 2nd

TRAVEL TEAMS FOR 6TH - 8TH GRADERS – 6th – 8th Grade Leagues consist of Weeknight & Saturday Practices and Sunday Games (September through the end of November). Teams will travel to neighboring towns and play at Millburn High School. League schedules will be distributed to all players in early September. Practice times during the week may be between 3:30pm and 9:00pm, and Saturday practices may start between 9:00am and 1:00pm. Players are placed on teams based on grade. Practice will begin Tuesday, August 15th. (additional program information on back of this sheet)

INSTRUCTIONAL TRAVEL TEAMS FOR 4TH & 5TH GRADERS – 4th – 5th Grade Leagues consist of Weeknight & Saturday Practices and Sunday Games (September through the end of November). Teams will travel to neighboring towns and play at Millburn High School. League schedules will be distributed to all players in late August. Practice times during the week may be between 3:30pm and 8:00pm, and Saturday practices may start between 9:00am and 1:00pm. Players are placed on teams based on grade. Practice will begin Monday, August 15th. (additional program information on back of this sheet). **4th-5th graders will be allowed to register for both Tackle and Flag Football if they choose.**

You may choose to mail in your registration form to the Millburn Recreation Department, 375 Millburn Ave., Millburn, NJ 07041. Please note that \$50.00 of the registration fee will be returned if all football equipment is returned in good condition prior to the December 15th deadline. Your registration must be received by the June 2 deadline; registrations received after the deadline of June 2 will be placed on a waiting list with no guarantee of program participation. A child **MAY NOT** be registered for more than one program as football will conflict with the soccer, cross country, and volleyball programs (practices/games). **4th-5th graders may register for flag football and tackle football.**

*REFUND POLICY: NO REFUNDS are given once registered for the program unless refund is requested 30 days prior to the first meeting of the program. Refund processing fee of \$10.00 will apply. SPORT PARENT AND SPECTATOR CODE OF CONDUCT PLEDGE

I therefore agree:

1. I will remember that children participate to have fun and that the game is for youth not adults.
2. I will inform the coach of any physical disability or ailment that may affect the safety of my child or the safety of others.
3. I will learn the rules of the game and policies of the league.
4. I will refrain from on field coaching of my child or other players during games and practices, unless I am one of the official coaches of the team.
5. I (and my guests) will be a positive role model for my child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy and by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials, and spectators at every game, practice or other sporting event.
6. I (and my guests) will not encourage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach player, or parent such as booing and taunting; refusing to shake hand; or using profane language or gestures.
7. I will not encourage any behaviors or practices that would endanger the health and wellbeing of the athletes.
8. I will teach my child to play by the rules and to resolve conflicts without resorting by hostility or violence.
9. I will teach my child that doing one's best is more important than winning, so that my child will never feel defeated by the outcome of a game or his/her performance.
10. I will praise my child for competing fairly and trying hard, and make my child feel like a winner every time.
11. I will never ridicule or yell at my child or other participants for making mistake or losing a competition.
12. I will promote the emotional and physical well being of the athletes ahead of any personal desire I may have for my child to win.
13. I will respect the game officials, recreation officials & coaches and their authority during games and will never confront game officials, recreation officials & coaches prior to, during or immediately following a game and if necessary speak with coaches or recreation officials at an agreed upon time.

I also agree that if I fail to abide by the aforementioned rules and guidelines, I may be subject to disciplinary action that could include, but not limited to the following:
