

**TOWNSHIP OF MILLBURN  
ORDINANCE NO. 2505-18  
ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER VII "TRAFFIC" OF THE REVISED GENERAL  
ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MILLBURN**

**Statement of Purpose:** *This Ordinance eliminates the requirement that cars must be parked headed into a parking space and provides for an alternative of backing into such space.*

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Millburn in the County of Essex and State of New Jersey as follows:

**Section 1.** Article VII entitled "Traffic" of the Revised General Ordinances, Part II entitled "Traffic Regulation on Property Under Municipal or Board of Education Control" and particularly Section 7-35 entitled "Off Street Parking Lots; Permit Parking" is amended in its entirety to read:

**7-35.4 Parking Area; Manner of Parking.** The area available for the parking of vehicles in every municipal off-street parking lot maintained by the Township shall be suitably subdivided by pavement markings, or otherwise, into single-vehicle spaces, wholly within one (1) of which spaces, called a parking space, if available, each vehicle using such lot shall be parked, either headed into or backed into unless otherwise indicated by signs posted in such parking lot.

**Section 2.** The provisions of this Ordinance are severable and the invalidity of any phase, clause or part of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remainder of the Ordinance.

**Section 3.** This Ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication as required by law.
