

**TOWNSHIP OF MILLBURN
ORDINANCE NO. 2508-18
AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MILLBURN, COUNTY OF ESSEX,
STATE OF NEW JERSEY,
AMENDING CHAPTER VII “TRAFFIC” OF THE REVISED GENERAL
ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MILLBURN**

Statement of Purpose: This Ordinance will correct certain conflicts with posted signage on Millburn Avenue, establish a subsection for three (3) hour metered parking and further establish three (3) hour parking on certain sections of Millburn Avenue.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Millburn in the City of Essex and State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. Article VII entitled “Traffic” of the Revised General Ordinances, Section 11 entitled “Parking Time Limited on Certain Streets” and particularly Sections 7-11.1 entitled “Time Limit Parking”, is amended as follows:

7-11.1 Time Limit Parking.

Remove:

Millburn Avenue	North	1 Hour	9:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m.	From the intersection of Millburn Avenue and Short Hills Avenue westerly to the intersection of Millburn Avenue and Baltusrol Way
Millburn Avenue	South	1 Hour	9:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m.	From the intersection of Millburn Avenue and Short Hills Avenue westerly to the easterly line of Glenwood Drive as extended
Millburn Avenue	South	3 Hours	9:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m.	From the intersection of the easterly line of Glenwood Drive as extended to the westerly line of Baltusrol Way as extended
Millburn Avenue	North	15 Min.	All day	From Farley Place to Morris Turnpike
Millburn Avenue	North	2 Hours	9:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m.	Between its intersection with Baltusrol Way and Farley Place

Millburn Avenue	South	1 Hour	9:30 a.m. - 6:30 p.m.	From the intersection of Millburn Avenue and Spring Street easterly to Parkview Drive
Millburn Avenue	North	1 Hour	9:30 a.m. - 6:30 p.m.	From the intersection of Millburn Avenue and Spring Street easterly to Wyoming Avenue

Add:

Millburn Avenue	North	3 Hours	9:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m.	From 380 feet easterly of Morris Turnpike to Short Hills Avenue
Millburn Avenue	South	3 Hours	9:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m.	From the intersection of Morris Turnpike easterly for a distance of 390 feet and 730 feet easterly from Morris Turnpike to Short Hills Avenue
Millburn Avenue	South	2 Hours	9:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m.	From the intersection of Millburn Avenue and Douglas Street easterly to 100 feet westerly of Parkview Drive
Millburn Avenue	North	2 Hours	9:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m.	From the intersection of Millburn Avenue and Douglas Street easterly to Parkview Drive

Section 2. Article VII entitled “Traffic” of the Revised General Ordinances, Section 11 entitled “Parking Time Limited on Certain Streets” and particularly Section 7-11.2 entitled “Metered Time Limit Parking”, is amended as follows:

d. *Two Hour Zones.* The following named streets or parts thereof are designated as two (2) hour zones:

Remove:

Millburn Avenue, along both sides from the intersection of Short Hills Avenue to Morris and Essex Turnpike (a.k.a. Route 124).

Millburn Avenue, along the northerly side, between its intersection with Short Hills Avenue and Farley Place.

Add:

Millburn Avenue, along both sides from the intersection of Douglas Street to Spring Street.

Add:

e. *Three Hour Zones.* The following named streets or parts thereof are designated as three (3) hour zones:

Millburn Avenue, along both sides from the intersection of Short Hills Avenue to Morris and Essex Turnpike (a.k.a. Route 124).

Section 3. Article VII entitled “Traffic” of the Revised General Ordinances, Section 11 entitled “Parking Time Limited on Certain Streets” is hereby amended to add a new section 7-11.3 entitled “On Street Permit Parking” as follows:

Add:

7-11.3, On Street Permit Parking

The purpose of this section is to designate on street permit parking areas:

<i>Name of Street</i>	<i>Side</i>	<i>Permit Type</i>	<i>Location</i>
Millburn Ave	South	Business	From 400 feet easterly of Morris Turnpike for a distance of 300 feet

Section 4. The provisions of this Ordinance are severable and the invalidity of any phase, clause or part of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remainder of the Ordinance.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication as required by law.
