ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER VII "TRAFFIC"  
OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MILLBURN**

**STATEMENT OF PURPOSE:** *The proposed amendment to the Traffic Ordinance is intended to amend Chapter VII "Traffic" as necessary to update traffic regulations for conformity throughout the Section, and to modify the parking and traffic regulations imposed throughout the Township. Specifically, the Ordinance modifies time limit restrictions on certain streets, clarifies parking meter zones, modifies where on street permit parking is required, modifies where parking is prohibited and at which times, and creates Residential Parking Zones and permitting requirements. Further, the Ordinance inserts the locations of Mid-Block Crossings, adds an area where trucks are excluded over a designated weight, adds a location where turning on red is prohibited, adds locations deemed as loading zones, updates the locations of Bus Stops, and modifies the parking restrictions and designation of Township or Board of Education parking lots. Additionally, the Ordinance updates the storage charge associated with towing a vehicle, modifies the permitting fees section, and modifies where parking is prohibited at the Essex Street Police Station driveways.*

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Millburn in the County of Essex and State of New Jersey, as follows:

**Section 1.** Section 7-1.3 is hereby added to Chapter VII entitled "Traffic" of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Millburn, Part I, "On Street Traffic Regulations," to read as follows:

As used in this Section:

**Legal Holidays** shall mean New Year's Day, Martin Luther King, Jr. Day, Washington's Birthday also referred to as Presidents Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Columbus Day, Veterans Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day, in accordance with 5 U.S.C.A. § 6103(a), as the days observed as federal Legal Holidays.

**Parking Meter** shall mean any mechanical device or meter placed or erected for the regulation of traffic by authority of this section. Each parking meter installed shall indicate by proper legend the legal parking time established by the Township, and when operated, shall at all times indicate the balance of legal parking time, and at the expiration of such period, shall indicate illegal or overtime parking.

**Section 2.** Chapter VII entitled "Traffic" of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Millburn, Part I, "On Street Traffic Regulations," Section 7-11.1, "Time Limit Parking," is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

No person shall park a vehicle for longer than the time limit between the hours listed on any day (except Sundays and Legal Holidays) upon any of the streets or parts of streets described.

**Section 3.** Chapter VII entitled “Traffic” of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Millburn, Part I, “On Street Traffic Regulations,” Section 7-11.2, “Metered Time Limit Parking,” is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

a. *Purpose of Use of Parking Meters.* It is hereby determined and stated that the control of vehicular traffic upon the public streets of the Township will be facilitated and the public safety and general welfare will be enhanced by the use of parking meters as a means of regulation of parking in and for certain areas of such streets, hereinafter designated as metered parking zones.

b. *Parking Meter Zones—Types; Markings; Signs.*

1. *Types of Zones.* There shall be four (4) kinds of on-street parking meter or paystation zones: The first kind is designated as a one (1) hour meter or paystation zone in which parking shall be permitted for one (1) continuous period of sixty (60) minutes. The second kind is designated as a two (2) hour meter or paystation zone in which parking shall be permitted for up to one (1) continuous period of up to two (2) hours. The third kind is designated as a three (3) hour meter or paystation zone in which parking shall be permitted for up to one (1) continuous period of three (3) hours. The fourth kind is designated as a twelve (12) hour meter zone in which parking shall be permitted for one (1) continuous period of up to twelve (12) hours.

The fees for one (1), two (2) and three (3) hour spaces controlled by a meter shall be a range of fifty cents (\$.50) to seventy-five cents (\$.75) per hour.

The fee set forth for twelve (12) hour spaces controlled by a meter shall be ten dollars (\$10.00).

c. *Twelve Hour Zones.* The following named streets or parts thereof are hereby designated as twelve (12) hour zones which require resident stickers:

Chatham Road, along the northerly side, beginning at a point two hundred one (201’) feet west of the westerly side line of Woodland Road, if projected, to such northerly side line of Chatham Road and running westerly for a distance of one hundred seventy-six (176’) feet; and further beginning at a point fifty (50’) feet east of the easterly side line of Forest Drive and running easterly along Chatham Road a distance of two hundred ninety-five (295’) feet.

- d. *Signs; Installation and Operation of Meters; Manner of Parking.* Signs shall be installed in all metered parking zones specifying the time limits during which parking is permitted, which signs shall be in conformity with N.J.S.A. 39:4-183.17. The Chief of Police shall cause lines or markings to be painted or placed upon the curb and street pavement adjacent to each parking meter installed pursuant to the provisions of this section, for the purpose of designating the parking space for which such meter is to be used, and each vehicle parked adjacent to any such meter shall be placed within the lines or markings so delineated. No parking meter shall be installed or placed in any area in which parking is prohibited by the laws of the State.
- e. *How Parking Meter and Space to Be Used; Overtime Parking.*
1. Parking spaces in the one (1) hour, two (2) hour, three (3) hour, and twelve (12) hour zones may lawfully be occupied upon depositing in the meter controlling the parking space the proper coins as specified in paragraph b of subsection 7-11.2.
  2. **Overtime Parking.** If any vehicle shall, as indicated by the meter controlling the parking space, remain parked in any such parking space beyond the parking time limit prescribed in paragraph b. of subsection 7-11.2 for the coin deposit made, the person who parked the vehicle in that location, or the registered owner thereof, shall be deemed to have violated the provisions of this section; provided further, however, that no motor vehicle shall occupy the same delineated parking space for more than one (1) period of time for which parking is permitted in such space and any motor vehicle that shall be parked for more than one (1) period for which parking is permitted in such space shall be in violation of this section even though the required parking fee for the additional period or periods has been deposited in the meter controlling the parking space in which the motor vehicle is parked.  
  
When any vehicle remains parked in any parking space beyond the parking time limit prescribed for such space, each such period of time that the vehicle remains in such parking space after the expiration of the initial period of time shall constitute a separate violation irrespective of whether or not payment has been deposited in the meter for the additional period or periods of time.
- f. *Use of Slugs in Meters; Tampering with Meters.* Depositing or causing to be deposited in any parking meter any slug, device or substitute for the aforesaid United States coin, or defacing, injuring or, without lawful authorization, tampering with, opening or willfully breaking, destroying or impairing the usefulness of any parking meter installed pursuant to this section shall constitute a violation of the provisions thereof, and upon conviction therefor, shall be punished as provided in Chapter I, Section 1-5.
- g. *Hours and Days Meters to Operate.* The time limitations and coin deposit requirements specified by this section shall be deemed effective between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. daily, except on Sundays and Legal Holidays; excepting, however, the east side of Main Street between Taylor Street and Millburn Avenue between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m., and 4:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. when no parking shall be permitted; and further excepting, the portion of Chatham Road, along the northerly side, beginning at a point two hundred one (201') feet west of the westerly side line of Woodland Road, a distance of one hundred seventy-six (176') feet; and further beginning at a point fifty (50') feet east of the easterly side line of Forest Drive and running easterly along Chatham Road a distance of two hundred ninety-five (295') feet on Saturdays when the meters governing this area shall not be in operation.
- h. *Reserved*

**Section 4.** Chapter VII entitled “Traffic” of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Millburn, Part I, “On Street Traffic Regulations,” Section 7-11.3, “On Street Permit Parking,” is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

The purpose of this section is to designate on street permit parking areas. The following are On Street Permit Parking Areas:

No person shall park a vehicle at any time upon any streets or parts thereof described.

**Section 7.** Chapter VII entitled “Traffic” of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Millburn, Part I, “On Street Traffic Regulations,” is hereby amended to add a new Section 7-14.2 entitled “Residential Parking Zones,” is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

Residents with a valid Residential Parking Zone permit are permitted to park within the Residential Parking Zone in which they reside outside of the posted time restrictions established within this Section 7. Residents are not permitted to park where parking is restricted at all times.

- a. Residents must establish proof of residency within a Residential Parking Zone by applying to the Township of Millburn to receive a resident parking zone permit.
- b. It shall be unlawful to sell, rent, transfer, lease or otherwise allow the use of a residential parking zone permit to any persons that do not reside on the designated streets of any established zone. Any resident of a zone that sells, rents, transfers, leases or otherwise allows for the use of their residential parking zone permit by someone other than a resident of the zone shall have their permit voided and considered invalid for a period of one (1) year.
- c. Residential parking zone permits must be distinguished differently than the general resident permit issued by the Township of Millburn.
- d. The following are established as Residential Parking Zones:

**Section 13.** Chapter VII entitled "Traffic" of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Millburn, Part II, "Traffic Regulations on Property Under Municipal or Board of Education Control," Section 7-35.6, "Time Limitations; Parking Prohibited During Certain Hours," is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

- a. Time limitations for permit parking spaces shall be either from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. or for twenty-four (24) hours and for metered parking spaces from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. No vehicle shall be parked on any off-street parking lot, including the off-street parking lot at the Millburn High School off Millburn Avenue, between the hours of 2:30 a.m. and 5:30 a.m.; except that twenty-four (24) hour parking shall be allowed by permit only solely at designated spaces in Lots Number 2, 6 and 14 for vehicles displaying proper Township permit(s).
- b. Lot Number 6 shall be signed for no more than twenty-one (21) twenty-four (24) hour permits which shall be issued to Township residents only.
- c. Lots Number 2, 6 and 14 shall be signed to provide for twenty-four (24) hour permits which shall be issued to Township residents only, on an as-needed basis.

**Section 14.** Chapter VII entitled "Traffic" of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Millburn, Part II, "Traffic Regulations on Property Under Municipal or Board of Education Control," Section 7-35.7, "Designation of Types of Lots," is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

No parking in off-street parking lots in the Township shall be permitted except by (1) valid permit issued by the Township; (2) depositing the correct payment in the meter controlling the parking space; (3) a vehicle having a special handicapped person's license plate parked in a space specifically designated as parking for such vehicles; or (4) as otherwise provided for in this subsection.

- a. Lot Number 1 (118 spaces), located at Essex Street and Main Street, shall have:
  1. Ninety-five (95) three (3)-hour meter spaces;
  2. Twenty (20) business (only) permit parking spaces; and
  3. Three (3) handicapped parking spaces.
- b. Lot Number 2 (400 spaces), located at Essex Street and Lackawanna Place, shall have:
  1. Two hundred and eighty one (281) permit parking spaces;
  2. Forty-four (44) three (3)-hour meter spaces;
  3. Nineteen (19) twenty-four (24) hour permit spaces;
  4. Forty-eight (48) business (only) permit parking spaces; and
  5. Eight (8) handicapped parking space.
- c. Lot Number 3 (194 spaces), located at Chatham Road, shall, except for the meter parking spaces, be a permit parking only area restricted to vehicles which display a valid resident's permit or for those whose full-time business or employment is in the Township with a valid nonresident's permit. Lot Number 3 shall have:
  1. One hundred seventy-seven (177) permit parking spaces;
  2. Six (6) handicapped parking spaces; and
  3. Eleven (11) business (only) permit parking spaces.
- d. Lot Number 4 (59 spaces), located on Taylor Street, shall have:
  1. Nineteen (19) three (3)-hour meter parking spaces;

2. Twenty-eight (28) permit parking spaces;
  3. Two (2) handicapped parking space; and
  4. Ten (10) combination three (3)-hour meter parking and permit parking spaces.
- e. Lot Number 5 (74 spaces), located on the northerly side of Millburn Avenue and adjoining the Town Hall on the east, shall have:
1. Sixty-five (65) three (3)-hour meter parking spaces;
  2. Six (6) parking spaces at no fee for municipal business; and
  3. Three (3) handicapped parking spaces.
- f. Lot Number 6 (29 spaces), located on the northerly side of Millburn Avenue and adjoining the Town Hall on the west, shall have:
1. Twenty-seven (27) combination spaces for business or twenty-four (24) hour parking permits; and
  2. Two (2) handicapped parking spaces.
- g. Lot Number 7 (307 spaces), abutting the concrete platform adjoining the westbound tracks of New Jersey Transit, at the Millburn Station, shall have:
1. Two hundred seventy-seven (277) permit parking spaces;
  2. Nine (9) three (3)-hour meter parking spaces;
  3. Eight (8) spaces reserved for the Millburn–Short Hills Volunteer First Aid Squad;
  4. Four (4) handicapped parking spaces;
  5. Eight (8) reserved spaces; and
  6. One (1) space reserved for ticket agent.

All night parking shall be allowed by request and approval of the Millburn Police Department only in Lot Number 7 on Saturdays, Sundays and Legal Holidays between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m.

- h. Lot Number 8 (84 spaces), located at the intersection of Chatham Road with Short Hills Avenue and Baltusrol Way, shall be a permit-parking-only area restricted to vehicles which display a valid permit. The requirements of this section shall not be in effect for Lot 8 on Saturdays, Sundays and Legal Holidays.
- i. Lot Number 9 (112 spaces), located at the intersection of Glen Avenue and Lackawanna Place, shall have:
1. Seventeen (17) twelve (12) hour meter parking spaces to be located and designated pursuant to subsection 7-35.8 to be used by vehicles bearing valid Township resident parking decals on weekdays.
  2. Forty-one (41) permit parking spaces.
  3. Sixteen (16) parking spaces are hereby designated as "Library Patronage Parking Lot" spaces and shall be restricted solely for the use of library patrons, with parking time limited to three (3) hours.
  4. Four (4) parking spaces designated for handicapped use.

The requirements of this section shall not be in effect for Lot Number 9 on Saturdays, Sundays and Legal Holidays. Parking shall be allowed only in Lot Number 9 for vehicles displaying a valid permit.

- j. Lot Number 10 (9 spaces), located on the northerly side of Chatham Road some three hundred fifty-seven (357) feet, more or less, from the intersection of the easterly side line of Forest Drive, shall be a permit-parking-only area restricted to vehicles which display a valid "resident's permit" or a valid "nonresident's, whose full-time business or employment is in the Township, permit." The requirements of this section shall not be in effect for Lot Number 10 on Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays.



k. Lot Number 11 (16 spaces), located on Chatham Road to the east and west of the Short Hills Railroad Station (eastbound side), shall have:

1. Twelve (12) permit parking spaces restricted to vehicles which display a valid Township permit;
2. Two (2) parking spaces restricted for the use of the employees of the railroad station; and
3. Two (2) handicapped parking spaces.

The requirements of this section shall not be in effect for Lot Number 11 on Saturdays, Sundays and Legal Holidays.

l. Lot Number 12 (15 spaces), located at 326 Millburn Avenue, shall have fourteen (14) one (1)-hour meter parking spaces and one (1) handicapped parking space.

m. Lot Number 13 (40 spaces), adjoining the Millburn Public Library, is hereby designated as the "Library Patronage Parking Lot" and shall have thirty-nine (39) spaces restricted solely for the use of library patrons with parking time limited to three (3) hours and one (1) handicapped parking space.

n. Lot Number 14 (98 spaces), located at Short Hills Avenue and Jarvis Lane, shall have:

1. Nineteen (19) two (2)-hour meter parking spaces;
2. Seventy-five (75) permit parking spaces, including fourteen (14) twenty-four (24) hour permit parking spaces, twenty-six (26) business parking spaces, and thirty-five (35) permit parking spaces that may be used for both business and twenty-four (24)-hours parking; and
3. Four (4) handicapped parking spaces.

o. Lot Number 16 (27 spaces), located on the westerly side of Main Street directly across Main Street from Block 701, Lot 2, shall have twenty-seven (27) permit parking spaces.

p. Lot Number 17 (24 spaces), located on Essex Street westerly of the Public Works Building, shall have twenty-four (24) parking spaces restricted for use by Township employees' vehicles which display a Township employee parking permit.

q. Lot Number 19 (72 spaces), located on Spring Street, between Millburn Avenue and Essex Street, shall have 60 Business Permit Spaces and 12 Municipal Employee Spaces.

**Section 15.** Chapter VII entitled "Traffic" of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Millburn, Part II, "Traffic Regulations on Property Under Municipal or Board of Education Control," Section 7-35.11, "Duty of Police in Case of Overtime Parking; Towing and Storage Charge," is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

Any vehicle parked on any municipal parking lot for a period in excess of one (1) hour succeeding the expiration of the period permitted for the fee deposited in the parking meter controlling the space in which such vehicle is parked, or, if such vehicle is parked during the period when the parking meter fee requirements are not applicable, and parking in such lot is prohibited, if such vehicle is parked for a period in excess of one (1) hour, or if a vehicle is parked without a permit in a lot or space restricted to permit parking, such vehicle may be towed, under the direction of the officer in charge of the Police Department, to a location designated by the Chief of Police and there is impounded, subject to redemption by the owner upon payment of the cost of towing and a storage charge consistent with section 4-39, "Vehicle Towing and Storage Services", during which such vehicle remains in such location, in addition to any fine imposed for the violation of this section.

**Section 16.** Chapter VII entitled "Traffic" of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Millburn, Part II, "Traffic Regulations on Property Under Municipal or Board of Education Control," Section 7-35.13, "Permits – Issuance; Schedule of Fees," is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

Any Township employee designated by the Business Administrator shall be authorized to issue the permits prescribed by this section and to accept the fees herein prescribed. The following types of permits and schedule of fees are hereby established:

- a. *Commuter Permit.*
  - 1. Annual permit fee.
    - (a) First car in a household..... \$620.00
    - (b) Each additional car in household..... \$680.00 each
  - 2. Semiannual permit fee.
    - (a) First car in a household..... \$455.00
    - (b) Each additional car in household..... \$505.00 each
- b. *Business, Whose Full-Time Business or Employment Is in This Township.*
  - 1. Annual permit fee..... \$230.00 to \$450.00
  - 2. Semiannual..... \$215.00 to \$415.00
  - 3. Annual transferable permit fee..... \$300.00 to \$500.00
  - 4. Annual remote restricted business permit.  
(use restricted to Lot 16 and Lot 19)..... \$150.00
  - 5. Part-time business permits where designated.....\$3.00-\$5.00/day
- c. *Resident’s Twenty-Four (24) Hour Permit.*
  - 1. Annual permit fee..... \$300.00
  - 2. Semiannual permit fee..... \$200.00
- d. *Transfer Fee.*
  - 1. Transfer of permit to another vehicle..... \$ 2.00
  - 2. Transfer penalty (failure to return original sticker upon transfer)... \$20.00
- e. *Summer Intern Permit (May 1st – September 1st).*
  - 1. Summer intern permit (use restricted to lots 14, 16 and 19)..... \$75.00
- f. For categories where ranges are established herewith, the fee shall be set by resolution of Township Committee.

**Section 17.** Chapter VII entitled “Traffic” of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Millburn, Part II, “Traffic Regulations on Property Under Municipal or Board of Education Control,” Section 7-35.20, “Essex Street Police Station Driveways,” is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

The easterly driveway to the Township Law Enforcement Building situated on Essex Street shall be for entering only, and the westerly driveway shall be for an exit only. Parking along the easterly driveway for a distance of one hundred forty-five (145') feet from its intersection with Essex Street is prohibited.

**Section 18.** Except for as provided above, the remainder of Chapter VII, “Traffic” shall remain in full force and effect.

**Section 19.** The provisions of this ordinance are severable and the invalidity of any phrase, clause or part of this ordinance shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remainder of this ordinance.

**Section 20.** This ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication as required by law.
