GIRLS T-BALL SOFTBALL - 2019

(Kindergarteners)



PROGRAM: Girls Kindergarten T-Ball Softball provides instruction on the game of softball. Sessions are one hour long and will be held each Saturday beginning April 6 at Taylor Park. Session starting times will be between the hours of 8:30am and 3:30pm. The last session is scheduled for June 1 (no sessions on April 13 and April 20). Players will hit a stationary ball off a batting tee, which will be placed by an instructor (Millburn Rec. Staff and volunteer parent). Instruction will include hitting, fielding, base running, and the basic rules of the game. Instruction and practice games will be held each Saturday. Youth will be placed in groups and parents will be notified by e-mail during the last week of March as to the time of their child's first session, which begins on Saturday, April 6. Shirts and hats will be handed out at the first session. Players will need to bring their own softball glove. Instruction will be provided by Recreation Department staff.

I therefore agree:

1. I will remember that children participate to have fun and that the game is for youth not adults.
2. I will inform the coach of any physical disability or ailment that may affect the safety of my child or the safety of others.
3. I will learn the rules of the game and the policies of the league.
4. I will refrain from on field coaching of my child or other players during games and practices, unless I am one of the official coaches of the team.
5. I (and my guests or spouse) will be a positive role model for my child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy and by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials and spectators at every game, practice or other sporting event.
6. I (and my guests or spouse) will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach player, or parent such as booing and taunting; refusing to shake hand; or using profane language or gestures.
7. I will not encourage any behaviors or practices that would endanger the health and wellbeing of the athletes.
8. I will teach my child to play by the rules and to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.
9. I will teach my child that doing one's best is more important than winning, so that my child will never feel defeated by the outcome of a game or his/her performance.
10. I will praise my child for competing fairly and trying hard, and make my child feel like a winner every time.
11. I will never ridicule or yell at my child or other participants for making a mistake or losing a competition.
12. I will promote the emotional and physical well being of the athletes ahead of any personal desire I may have for my child to win.
13. I (and my guests or spouse) will respect the game officials, recreation officials & coaches and their authority during games and will never question or confront game officials, recreation officials & coaches prior to, during or immediately following a game and if necessary speak with coaches or recreation officials at an agreed upon time.

I (and my guests or spouse) also agree that if we fail to abide by the aforementioned rules and guidelines, I or they may be subject to disciplinary action that could include, but is not limited to the following:
