

**TOWNSHIP OF MILLBURN
ORDINANCE NO. 2549-19
AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES
OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MILLBURN, CHAPTER VII "TRAFFIC", SUBSECTIONS 7-11.1, 7-
35.13 and 7-35.18**

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: *the purpose of this Ordinance is to increase fees for twenty-four (24) hour parking permits, establish definitions for those eligible to be issued a twenty-four (24) hour parking permit and to create a new permit for eligible residents to park overnight in designated Township owned parking lots. The ordinance also increases the transfer fee for permits from \$2.00 to \$5.00.*

This ordinance further clarifies section 7-11.1 to establish parking restrictions on Cypress Street due to an omission in Ordinance 2544-19 previously adopted on November 11, 2019.

Section 1. Article 7 "Traffic", Subsection 7-11.1, 7-35.13 and 7-35.18 is hereby amended and supplemented by deleting existing text as per the ~~strike through~~ and adding new text as underlined below

Section 2. Chapter VII entitled "Traffic" of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Millburn, Part I, "On Street Traffic Regulations," Section 7-11.1, "Time Limit Parking," is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

No person shall park a vehicle for longer than the time limit between the hours listed on any day (except Sundays and Legal Holidays) upon any of the streets or parts of streets described.

Section 3. Chapter VII entitled "Traffic" of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Millburn, Part II, "Traffic Regulations on Property Under Municipal or Board of Education Control" Section 7-35.13, "Off-Street Parking Lots; Permit Parking," is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

7-35.13 Permits-Issuance; Schedule of Fees.

Any Township employee designated by the Business Administrator shall be authorized to issue the permits prescribed by this section and to accept the fees herein prescribed. The following types of permits and schedule of fees are hereby established:

a. Resident's Commuter Permit.

1. Annual permit fee.

(a) First car in a household \$620.00

(b) Each additional car in household \$680.00 each

2. Semiannual permit fee.

(a) First car in a household \$455.00

(b) Each additional car in household \$505.00 each

b. *Business, Whose Full-Time Business or Employment Is in This Township.*

1. Annual permit fee. \$230.00 to \$450.00

2. Semiannual \$215.00 to \$415.00

3. Annual transferable permit fee \$300.00 to \$500.00

4. Annual remote restricted business permit.

... (use restricted to Lot 16 and Lot 19) \$150.00

5. Part-time business permits where designated \$3.00-\$5.00/day

c. *Resident's Twenty-Four (24) Hour Permit.*

~~1. Annual permit fee \$300.00~~

~~2. Semiannual permit fee \$200.00~~

1. Annual permit fee.

(a) First car in a household \$620.00

(b) Additional car in household \$680.00

2. Semiannual permit fee.

(a) First car in a household \$455.00

(b) Additional car in household \$505.00

3. Twenty-Four (24) Hour permits will be issued only to tenants that reside in the B-4 commercial district as zoned or those residents that reside in the B-3 commercial district as zoned along Millburn Avenue between Short Hills Avenue and Morris Turnpike.

- 4. Permits will be limited to two (2) per apartment unit.
- 5. A copy of a current rental lease must be provided with application in order for a twenty-four (24) permit to be issued.
- 6. All other rules and requirements established by the permit application shall be adhered to by the permit holder

d. Overnight Parking Permits for Designated Lots

- 1. Annual permit fee \$225.00
- 2. Use of the permit will be permitted in designated shopper parking spaces in Lot 2 and Lot 14 Monday-Saturday 6:00pm to 8:00am, Sunday all day.
- 3. Overnight parking permits will be issued only to tenants that reside in the B-4 commercial district as zoned or to those residents that reside in the B-3 commercial district as zoned along Millburn Avenue between Short Hills Avenue and Morris Turnpike.
- 4. A copy of a current rental lease must be provided with application in order for a twenty-four (24) permit to be issued.
- 5. All other rules and requirements established by the permit application shall be adhered to by the permit holder.

~~e.~~ e. Transfer Fee.

- 1. Transfer of permit to another vehicle \$—~~2.00~~ \$5.00
- 2. Transfer penalty (failure to return original sticker upon transfer) \$20.00

~~e.~~ f. Resident’s Summer Intern Permit (May 1st – September 1st).

- 1. Summer intern permit (use restricted to lots 14, 16 and 19) \$75.00

~~f.~~ g. For categories where ranges are established herewith, the fee shall be set by resolution of Township Committee.

Section 4. Chapter VII entitled “Traffic” of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Millburn, Part II, “Traffic Regulations on Property Under Municipal or Board of Education Control” Section 7-35.18, “Transfer of Permit,” is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

7-35.18 Transfer of Permit.

An unexpired permit issued pursuant to this section may be transferred from the vehicle for which it was issued to another vehicle owned by the licensee provided that the licensee shall submit an application for such transfer and a fee of ~~one five dollars (\$1.00)~~ (\$5.00) to cover the cost of effecting the same. The owner of the vehicle shall either surrender the insignia placed upon the rear window of such vehicle in a defaced condition to the Township designee or submit such vehicle to the Township designee so that the insignia may be removed. The permit shall also be submitted, together with the vehicle to which the permit is to be transferred, in order that the necessary changes may be made in such permit and a new insignia placed upon the vehicle to which the permit is transferred. (1967 Code § 24-10-18)

Section 5. Except for as provided above, the remainder of Chapter VII, “Traffic” shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 6. The provisions of this ordinance are severable and the invalidity of any phrase, clause or part of this ordinance shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remainder of this ordinance.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication as required by law.
