1st through 8th Grade IN-TOWN LEAGUES 7th-8th Grade SUBURBAN TRAVEL TEAM (fast pitch)

PROGRAM: 1st through 8th graders. In-town leagues for 1st-8th graders and Travel Team for 7th-8th graders. 1st-2nd and 3rd-4th grade leagues practice weeknights and play games on Saturdays at Glenwood School. 5th-6th grade league and 7th-8th grade league practices weeknights and play games weeknights and Saturdays in Millburn, Livingston, and Caldwell (intra-town leagues). Practices for all teams are various weeknight evenings April through June. 7th- 8th grade travel team home games are played on various weeknights and Saturdays at High School or Taylor Park while away games are at towns in Essex County; practices vary weeknights/weekends from the end of March through June.

GIRL'S SOFTBALL LEAGUE INFORMATION

1st – 2nd GRADES – Practices begin week of March 23rd. Teams will practice one day per week (Mon-Fri). Games begin Saturday, April 4. Teams will play Saturdays (mornings/afternoons) at Glenwood School. Practice day and time for in-town teams are chosen by the volunteer team coach. This league will be coach pitch with no playoffs.

**** 1st – 2nd GRADE PLAYERS DO NOT TRY OUT ****

3rd – 4th GRADES – Practices begin week of March 23rd. Teams will practice one day per week (Mon-Sat). Games begin Saturday, April 4. Teams will play Saturdays (mornings/afternoons) at Glenwood School. Practice day and time for in-town teams are chosen by the volunteer team coach. This league will be combined player/coach pitch with no playoffs.

**** 3rd-4th GRADE PLAYERS DO NOT TRY OUT ****

5th – 6th GRADES – Practices begin week of March 25th. Teams will practice one day per week (Mon-Sat). Games are weeknights and Saturdays in Millburn, Livingston, and Caldwell (intra-town league). Practice day and time for in-town teams are chosen by the volunteer team coach. This league will be player pitch with limited windmill pitching rules.

**** 5th-6th GRADE PLAYERS DO NOT TRY OUT ****

7th – 8th GRADES – Includes 7th-8th grade In-town League and 7th-8th Grade Suburban Travel Team. 7th-8th grade in-town league practices weeknights and play games weeknights and Saturdays in Millburn, Livingston, and Caldwell (intra-town league) In-town League practices begin week of March 23. In-Town Teams will practice once per week (Mon-Sat). Games begin late April. Practice day and time for in-town teams are chosen by the volunteer team coach.

The 7th-8th Grade Suburban Travel Team plays one or two weeknight games per week and possibly Saturdays. Travel Team Players MAY NOT play In-town recreation softball. The Suburban Travel Team also practices one weeknight and/or Saturday during the season. Commitment to the travel team is 3-4 days per week. An extra fee (\$45/player) for Travel Teams will be collected by the team's coach (prior to the first game). Please note that there is no guarantee of playing time for players on travel team.

7th – 8th GRADE PLAYER EVALUATION TRYOUTS FOR IN-TOWN TEAM PLACEMENT and SUBURBAN TRAVEL TEAM – MONDAY, MARCH 9th at the Middle School Upper Gym. If there are poor weather conditions, please call (973) 564-7096 for information. All players must wear sneakers if inside the gym.

Special requests for children to play on a specific team; be with a specific player; or be with a specific coach will not be honored due to the overwhelming number of children participating in this program.

SPORT PARENT AND SPECTATOR CODE OF CONDUCT PLEDGE (please read and sign on the bottom of this page)

I therefore agree:

1. I will remember that children participate to have fun and that the game is for youth not adults.
2. I will inform the coach of any physical disability or ailment that may affect the safety of my child or the safety of others.
3. I will learn the rules of the game and the policies of the league.
4. I will refrain from on field coaching of my child or other players during games and practices, unless I am one of the official coaches of the team.
5. I (and my guests or spouse) will be a positive role model for my child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy and by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials and spectators at every game, practice or other sporting event.
6. I (and my guests or spouse) will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach player, or parent such as booing and taunting; refusing to shake hand; or using profane language or gestures.
7. I will not encourage any behaviors or practices that would endanger the health and wellbeing of the athletes.
8. I will teach my child to play by the rules and to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.
9. I will teach my child that doing one's best is more important than winning, so that my child will never feel defeated by the outcome of a game or his/her performance.
10. I will praise my child for competing fairly and trying hard, and make my child feel like a winner every time.
11. I will never ridicule or yell at my child or other participants for making a mistake or losing a competition.
12. I will promote the emotional and physical well being of the athletes ahead of any personal desire I may have for my child to win.
13. I (and my guests or spouse) will respect the game officials, recreation officials & coaches and their authority during games and will never question or confront game officials, recreation officials & coaches prior to, during or immediately following a game and if necessary speak with coaches or recreation officials at an agreed upon time.

I (and my guests or spouse) also agree that if we fail to abide by the aforementioned rules and guidelines, I or they may be subject to disciplinary action that could include, but is not limited to the following:

- **Removal from game facility and or suspension from attendance of a parent or spectator at a future game or games.**
