May and warm weather is finally here and Golfing is opening up in NJ and in Millburn!! The Millburn Recreation Department's #1 priority is to provide a safe and enjoyable golf experience for our members and Golf Course Staff. There are new guidelines and restrictions in place for everyone's protection and to limit the spread of COVID-19.

MILLBURN PAR 3 GOLF COURSE

Policies/Guidelines - 5/2/2020

Who can play:

The Millburn Par 3 is open to 2020 Millburn Recreation Golf members. If you are not registered for the 2020 Golf season, go to bit.ly/millburnrecreg and you can register online with Community Pass. Returning members, bring your golf ID Badge. New members, please bring a copy of your email receipt to expedite check in at course. Memberships are available to Millburn residents, age 8 and older and to a limited # of non-residents.

Golfing is restricted to only 2 golfers per group, unless you are playing with immediate family or household members. If you or family members have displayed any symptoms or have been exposed to someone with COVID-19, please stay home.

How to pay greens fee:

Pay by credit card only, (MasterCard or Visa – no cash accepted). Your ID badge will be scanned (through a glass window) and you will swipe your credit card to pay the greens fee outside of the clubhouse window. Note: no membership registrations will be taken at clubhouse, online only – thank you. If a member is bringing a guest, the member must pay for the guest via credit card. If member is bringing other family members, one credit card transaction per group. Resident green fees are \$4 weekdays & \$6 weekends. Non-resident fees are \$6 & \$9 respectively. Guest fees are \$10 weekdays & \$13 on weekends.

Social Distancing & Face mask/coverings:

Golfers and staff, from the time they arrive in the parking lot till the time they return to their cars, must practice social distancing (a minimum of 6') and are required to wear face coverings if social distancing measures are difficult to maintain. Furthermore, anytime you are under the clubhouse roof (to pay greens fees), you must wear a face covering.

It is recommended that you also wear a face covering while playing and to maintain social distancing especially at the tee boxes and greens.

Only two golfers allowed under clubhouse roof/deck area at a time, others must form a line, 6' apart, outside clubhouse steps.

Golf Course Special Guidelines:

Just golf and fresh air for now – No scorecards, pencils, bathrooms (plan accordingly), putting green, rakes, ball washers, benches, club rental or cart rental (carry bag or bring your own cart). Avoid touching any fencing, gates, railings, etc. Course staff will clean/disinfect their work stations & area outside clubhouse window.

No touching of flagstick (special cups have been installed to easily retrieve your ball only).

In order to keep course open, you must adhere to policies & guidelines. Thank you for your cooperation! Life has changed, but together we can adapt, play golf and move to a better and healthier time.
