Press Release April 8, 2021

On March 22, 2021 Millburn Police Officer Kostovski responded to an Oakdale Ave residence on a report of a burglary to a motor vehicle. The resident reported that at 4:29 am an unknown male entered his 2005 Saturn and then attempted to enter another vehicle in his driveway. This incident is under investigation by the Millburn Police Detective Bureau.

On March 24, 2021 Millburn Police Officer Ford stopped a suspicious person who was removing security tags near Victoria's Secret at the Mall at Short Hills. Officers Kelly and Griffin arrived to assist and the investigation revealed that the subject, Ozzie Mckinnon, 49 years old of Newark was in possession of stolen property. Mckinnon was arrested, issued summonses and later released.

On March 24, 2021 Millburn Police Officer Matos responded to a Cross Gates residence on a report of a attempted burglary to a motor vehicle. The resident reported that at 2:00 am, 2 unknown black males attempted to enter vehicles in his driveway. This incident is under investigation by the Millburn Police Detective Bureau.

On March 24, 2021 Millburn Police Officers Aliotta and Recinos responded to a Meadowbrook Rd residence on a report of a burglary to a motor vehicle. The resident reported that at 4:33 am unknown actors entered his 2012 Honda while parked in his driveway. This incident is under investigation by the Millburn Police Detective Bureau.

On March 28, 2021 Millburn Police Officers Kerwien and Pinero responded to a Joanna Way residence on a report of an assault. During the investigation, it was determined that the assault occurred between two coworkers at the residence. Ms. Tatyana Korshunova, age 55, of Philadelphia, attempted to assault the victim again in front of the officers, and then she was placed under arrest. She was later charged with simple assault and released.

On April 1, 2021, Millburn Police Officer Matos responded to Tory Burch at The Mall at Short Hills for a report of a theft in progress. Tory Burch associates reported that an unknown black male entered the rear of the store and stole an associates purse, a black Dior handbag, and several other pieces of merchandise. Store associates attempted to chase after the suspect, but he got away from them. The merchandise was later found dumped in a parking lot outside the mall. This incident is under investigation by the Millburn Police Detective Bureau.

On April 5, 2021 at 3:28 pm, Millburn Police Officer Seebohm responded to Fairfield Drive on a report of a dispute. Upon arrival with other officers, the actor was located and was assaulting UPS driver. The actor, Labilatok Gbamou, age 21, of Elizabeth, resisted arrest when they attempted to take him into custody. Gbamou was arrested and charged with carjacking, aggravated assault, resisting arrest and theft. He was issued summonses and later released on his own recognizance.

On April 6, 2021 Millburn Police Officer Herrera responded to Neiman Marcus at The Mall at Short Hills for a report of a theft. Neiman Marcus associates reported that two unknown females entered the Burberry section and select a Burberry Handbag. The females cut the security cable and carried the bag

out of the store without making payment. This incident is under investigation by the Millburn Police Detective Bureau.

On April 7, 2021 Millburn Police Officer Dalakian responded to a suspicious male who committing a local ordinance violation at the Mall at Short Hills. Officer Dalakian located the subject, Earnest Rich, age 38, of Newark. The investigation revealed that Rich had an open warrant out of Newark. Rich was arrested, issued summonses and later released on his own recognizance.

These are accusations. All defendants are presumed innocent unless and until they enter a guilty plea or are found guilty in a court of law.
